LOWER SCHOOL LITERATURE BOOKS

Jr. Kindergarten: All books are read aloud by the teacher and include enrichment selections from *Myself and Others*, science, history, art, Bible, music, numbers, and letters.

Kindergarten: *Biscuit, Morris the Moose, Big Brown Bear, Sammy the Seal, The Horse in Harry's Room, Scamp and Tramp, Soft and White, Fun in the Sun*, Logic of English curriculum; Most read aloud books by the teacher include enrichment selections from *Myself and Others*, science, history, art, Bible, music, numbers, and letters.

*JK and K read aloud literature should be combined together, when possible.

Lower Grammar School Literature (1st - 3rd):

1st: *Logic of English* readers, *Little Bear* series, *Frog and Toad*, *Caps for Sale*, *Make Way for Ducklings*, *Billy and Blaze* series, *The Story About Ping*, *Keep the Lights Burning*, *Abbie*, *Stone Soup*, *The Little House*, *Miss Rumphius*, *Stories of for Little Americans*, *Visual Imaging Books*; Readers and Literature selections in the Logic of English: Foundations curriculum.

2nd: *Logic of English* readers, *Prairie School* (2-3), *Courage of Sarah Noble* (1-3), *Little House in the Big Woods* (2-3), *Tales from Beatrix Potter* (2-3), *Animal Folk Tales of America* (2-3), *Stories of for Little Americans*, *Visual Imaging Books*; Readers and Literature selections in the Logic of English: Foundations curriculum.

3rd: *Farmer Boy* (2-3), *Animal Folk Tales of America* (2-3), *Charlotte's Web* (2-3), *A Bear Called Paddington* (3-4), *Mr. Popper's Penguins* (3-4), *Stories of for Little Americans*, *Visual Imaging Books*;

*Other books read aloud by the teacher relate to science, history, art, Bible, music, and various great literature selections. *The Bronze Bow* is required to be read aloud. *Stories of for Little Americans* and *Visual Imaging* books are strongly encouraged, as time permits.

Upper Grammar School (4th - 6th): *The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe*, *Prince Caspian*, *Voyage of the Dawn Treader*, *Greek Myths*, *D'Aulaire*, *The Aeneid for Boys and Girls*, *The Bronze Bow*, *The Children's Homer*; Other books are read aloud by the teacher relating to science, history, art, Bible, music, and various great literature selections. They may include *The Horse and His Boy* (required), *Tales of Ancient Egypt*, *Tales of Greek Heroes*, *Theras and His Town* (Snedeker), *The Spartans* (Snedeker), *Red Sails to Capri* (Weil), and others.

*Comprehension Guides vary in difficulty based on grade-level.
