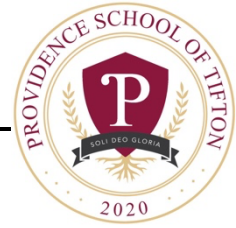

Students work through *Saxon Math 1*, using many manipulatives. Students progress at a moderate pace or advanced pace and may repeat the entire Saxon 1 program or move to Saxon 2 the following year.

Phonics, Penmanship, and Spelling

Logic of English, Foundations A & B

Our Orton-Gillingham approach begins by using LOE Foundations A to teach students every sound that each of the 25 single-letter phonograms make, plus the double-letter phonogram /qu/. They also learn blends, syllables, and "sounding out" words. During this quarter students learn how to correctly form every lowercase letter in cursive. Quarters two and three are spent working through Foundations B which teaches them how to correctly write every uppercase letter in cursive, learn 21-multi-level phonograms, and spell ten words per week using these phonograms as well as words that are exceptions to the spelling rules. Students learn a total of 378 high-frequency words.

Students read 22 phonics-controlled readers, then progress to more advanced readers as they are ready. Other books include:

Students progress through *First Language Lessons* with a concentration on nouns, verbs, parts of a sentence, and pronouns.
