TUITION AND FEES for all special needs students K3 - 8th grade:

ANNUAL TUITION PER STUDENT*	\$10,895 PER YEAR (\$7,895 for Half-Day Jr. K and Kindergarten)
ENROLLMENT FEE (a separate part of tuition; due within two weeks of applying)	\$350
ANNUAL CURRICULUM FEE (a separate part of tuition; due on June 1 or within two weeks of completing enrollment)	\$495 for K3-K4 \$695 for Kindergarten \$895 for 1 st - 6 th grade \$995 for 7 th – 8 th grade
TECHNOLOGY FEE**	\$250 for 7 th and 8 th grade

Our tuition and curriculum fees are listed above. Additionally, each family will be responsible for purchasing supplies, uniforms, and individual keep-at-home literature books. Once a family has enrolled, they will set up their tuition payment schedule (one-time or multiple payments are available) online through their family account.

Students receiving a scholarship should have their scholarship mailed to P.O. Box 1038, Tifton, Georgia, 31794 and received no later than July 30, 2021.

*Additional therapy needed will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis and may increase the cost of tuition.

FLEXIBLE TUITION PLAN:

We are committed to serving all of our like-minded community, not just those that seem to be able to afford a private education. Therefore, in an effort to serve our community of families with diverse socioeconomic backgrounds, we offer a Flexible Tuition Plan, based on need. All interested families must apply for the Flexible Tuition Plan by February 15. Flexible Tuition will be awarded based on need, as assessed by FACTS, and scholarship funds available. Family should not pay less than \$3,500 annually per student except in the case of extenuating circumstances. We are unable to offer the Flexible Tuition Plan to families entering mid-school year or to families receiving additional scholarship funds.

Tuition Payment Schedule:

If a family applies for the Flexible Tuition Plan, tuition may be paid using one of the following three plans:

- 1-Pay Plan: One lump sum payment. Payment can be made via check, money order, or FACTS.
- 2-Pay Plan: Two equal payments due before May 1 and January 1. Payments are administered by FACTS and applicants will incur a one-time \$50 FACTS enrollment fee. You may select the 5th or the 20th of the month as your payment date. A 2.85% credit card fee will apply to those paying by credit card.
- 12-Pay Plan: Twelve equal monthly payments due beginning May 1 and ending April 30. Monthly payments are administered by FACTS and applicants will incur a one-time \$50 FACTS enrollment fee. You may select the 5th or the 20th of the month as your payment date. A 2.85% credit card fee will apply to those paying by credit card.

Tuition Credits are available as follows:

- Paid in full by May 15, 2010: \$250 (may not be combined with any other discount).
- Referral Discount (student must have completed the enrollment process to qualify for the referral discount as both the referee and referral; half-time enrolled referrals will receive a 50% referral discount): \$350/each. Referral discounts may not be combined with student scholarships.

**Covers the cost of one Chromebook and programs per student, annually.
