Phonics, Penmanship, and Spelling

Logic of English, Foundations C & D

Building on LOE Foundations B, students learn 44 new spelling rules, spell multi-syllable words, read and spell 75 phonograms, identify 8 advanced phonograms, write contractions, use morphology to distinguish commonly confused words, and more.

Reading

Students read 24 fiction and non-fiction phonics-controlled readers, then progress to more advanced readers as they are ready. Students complete comprehension guides for all books read in class.
